**The Heart of Nuba** is an inspiring film telling the story of Dr. Tom Catena, a graduate of Brown University and Duke University School of Medicine, who has dedicated his life to the care of the Nuban people of Sudan. Single-handedly, Dr. Catena runs the Mother of Mercy Hospital in the Nuba Mountains, caring for those victims of the daily bombings ordered by the Sudanese dictator, President al-Bashir. Tom was a finalist for the 2016 Aurora Prize, and highlighted by Time Magazine as one of the 100 most influential people in 2015.
